Annual Meeting

The 2021 annual Tame Fish Lake Association meeting will be held a bit earlier this year on Saturday, June 5th at 5pm at Farrell's beach. The meeting will be followed by a social hour with cocktails. In case of bad weather, the meeting will be held in their pavilion. A reminder email will go out in late May.

Membership

Membership is \$30 annually and due by the annual meeting in order to be eligible to cast votes during that meeting. New members can sign up on the website in the membership section. Existing members should use the same form to make changes to contact information. Dues can be paid at the annual meeting or checks can be made payable to TFLA and sent to the association treasurer, Deb Gadbois, at 27544 S Tame Fish Lake Rd, Deerwood, MN 56444.

Zebra Mussels:

Zebra mussels were found to be present in our lake last year. The DNRs area supervisor for aquatic invasive species performed a brief inspection of the lake and confirmed the presence of the mussels.

Because our lake is not an ideal habitat for zebra mussels due to the lack of structure in 3+ feet of water, it was his opinion that we would not experience a serious infestation but may see annual fluctuations in populations.

We will discuss maintenance and what to expect at the annual meeting.

2021 Milfoil mitigation plan

We will once again treat the lake with Hydrothol-R to mitigate the milfoil infestation.

There are 10 bags left over from last year and the association will purchase 16 more bags for treating the lake according to the map at the end of this newsletter.

We will discuss in more detail at the meeting.

Key things you need to know now:

- Planned treatment is the first week in June with a second treatment at peak growth in early July (after the 4th of July weekend)
- We will mark the treatment areas with buoys the week prior
 - We need about 30 empty milk or water jugs with handles to use as buoys to mark the treatment area. Drop them off at Jack & Deb's place by May 15th if you have any.
 - Once the buoys are in place, please do not move or drive over them. They will be removed after the first treatment.
- For spreading the chemicals, we will need 3 pontoons each with 3 people each. If you are able to help, please let us know. It's easy and should take about 2 hours.
- The map below shows the 5 problem areas on the lake that the association will treat.
- If you would like to purchase Hydrothol R for treating your property frontage, please email tamefishlakeassn@gmail.com by May 1st. The cost is \$120 per 20 lb. bag. One bag should treat about 3 properties, so please coordinate with your neighbors if you would like.
- While the statement from the manufacture states there are no restrictions to swimmer or anglers, we would advise a 3-day waiting period after application.
