2024 Milfoil mitigation plan

Key things you need to know:

- The order for Hydrothol-R will be placed around April 8th. The association raised enough funds last year to pay for usual the targeted treatment areas. This was a great effort by the entire membership. We had record membership last year and raised additional money at the fundraiser.
- If you would like to order for your lakeshore, please submit your order AND payment to Deb Gadbois, payable to TFLA using the options above for dues. This year the cost is \$160 per bag. Unfortunately, there are not enough funds in the association account to pay for individual orders and collect later. If the order reaches the next quantity discount, the difference will be refunded.
- Jack Gadbois will monitor the lake temperature and let us know when to put in our treatment.
- For spreading the chemicals on the main lake, we will need help. Please consider participating as a spreader or pontoon driver.

Loon Platform
